SUB: - CONSTITUTION OF ANTI RAGGING SQUAD AND ANTI-RAGGING MONITORING CELL.

1. In pursuance of *Anti Ragging Committee meeting* held on 29 May, 2024, it was decided that in compliance of UGC anti ragging regulation 2009, '**Anti-Ragging Squad**' and '**Anti-Ragging Monitoring Cell**' need to be constituted. In compliance of the above, the following squad & cell are being constituted.

- Anti-Ragging Squad.**
- Anti-Ragging Monitoring Cell.**

2. **Anti-Ragging Squad.** The composition of the '**Anti-Ragging Squad**' is given below:-

3. **Roles & Responsibilities of 'Anti-Ragging Squad'.**

The Anti-Ragging Squad is established to ensure a safe and conducive environment for students in the University by preventing and addressing any instances of ragging. The role & responsibilities of the squad are enunciated in ensuing paragraphs.

- Surveillance and Monitoring.**
 - Conduct regular and surprise inspections in various areas such as hostels, canteen, classrooms and other student common areas.
 - Maintain a constant vigil on identified trouble spots to deter potential incidents of ragging.
- Reporting Mechanism.**
 - Establish a clear and confidential reporting system for students to report incidents of ragging.
 - Ensure that all complaints are taken seriously and investigated promptly.

(c) **Immediate Response.**

- (i) Act promptly in response to any reported or observed incidents of ragging.
- (ii) Intervene immediately to stop the incident and provide assistance to the victim.

(d) **Investigation.**

- (i) Conduct thorough investigations of reported incidents, ensuring fairness and confidentiality.
- (ii) Collect evidence, record statements from the involved parties, and prepare detailed reports.

(e) **Support and Counseling.**

- (i) Provide support and counseling services to victims of ragging to help them recover from the trauma.
- (ii) Offer counseling services to perpetrators to understand their behavior and encourage positive change.

(f) **Coordination with Authorities.**

- (i) Liaise with the Anti-Ragging Committee and other relevant authorities for comprehensive action against ragging
- (ii) Ensure that incidents are reported to the appropriate law enforcement agencies when necessary.

(g) **Enforcement of Regulations.**

- (i) Enforce anti-ragging policies strictly and ensure adherence to university and legal regulations.
- (ii) Recommend disciplinary actions against perpetrators in line with university policies.

(h) **Documentation.**

- (i) Maintain detailed records of all incidents of ragging, including reports, investigations, and actions taken.
- (ii) Ensure that these records are securely stored and readily accessible for review by authorities.

(i) **Feedback and Improvement.**

- (i) Collect feedback from students and staff on the effectiveness of anti-ragging measures.
- (ii) Regularly review and update strategies to improve the effectiveness of the squad's efforts.

(j) **Accountability.**

- (i) The Anti-Ragging Squad is accountable to the Anti-Ragging Committee and the competent authority of the university.
- (ii) Regular reports on activities, incidents, and measures taken should be submitted for review.

(k) **Training.** Members of the squad should receive regular training on the legal aspects of ragging, investigation techniques, and counseling skills to enhance their effectiveness.



4. **Anti Ragging Monitoring Cell.** The composition of the 'Anti-Ragging Monitoring Cell' is given below-

5. **Roles & Responsibilities of 'Anti-Ragging Monitoring Cell':**


- (a) **Compliance Monitoring.** Ensure schools comply with instructions of the university on conducting orientation programmes and counseling sessions on anti-ragging.
- (b) **Incident Reporting.** Gather detailed reports on incidents of ragging, problems faced by wardens and other officials.
- (c) **Review of Anti-Ragging Efforts.** Assess and review the efforts to publicize anti-ragging measures and initiatives.
- (d) **Verification of Undertakings.** Cross-verify the receipt of anti-ragging undertakings from students and their parents/guardians annually.
- (e) **Initiating University Action.** Act as the primary body to recommend and initiate amendments to the university's Statutes and Ordinances to facilitate the implementation of anti-ragging measures.
- (f) **Documentation and Reporting.** Maintain detailed records of compliance, incidents, and actions taken and ensure these records are available for review by university authorities.
- (g) **Support and Guidance.** Provide guidance and support in effectively implementing anti-ragging measures.

6. By fulfilling these roles and responsibilities, the *Anti-Ragging Squad & Anti-Ragging Monitoring Cell* play a critical role in fostering a safe and supportive educational environment. It is once again reiterated that for the benefit of all the stakeholders that ragging is a criminal offence and the perpetrators/ culprits will attract punitive action as per the UGC regulations mentioned above.
